DO YOU KNOW WHAT'S TRUE AND WHAT'S FALSE?

"CALLING MY TICKETS IN ON A MONDAY IS GOOD PLANNING."

FALSE Mondays are the busiest day at 811. Avoid long hold times on the phone by submitting your ticket at **Indiana811.org**.

"I KNOW WHERE ALL THE UTILITIES ARE ON MY PROPERTY, SO I DON'T NEED TO SUBMIT A TICKET."

FALSE Regardless of whether you think you know where utilities are buried, state law requires you to submit a locate request. Sometimes erosion or grading can unintentionally shift utilities, so it's always important to submit a locate request.

"IF A GAS LINE IS CUT, I SHOULD Try to stop the leak."

FALSE Leave the area immediately and call 911, the gas company and 811.

"I'M ONLY DOING A SMALL PROJECT (I.E. INSTALLING A MAILBOX, PLANTING A SHRUB, ETC.) SO I DON'T NEED TO SUBMIT A TICKET."

FALSE State law requires that anytime you break ground you are required to submit a locate request.
