Subject:	#2203 Biosolids Building Addition

The subject project includes two bays – one for the vactor truck and the other for a new workshop. This project also includes lighting and HVAC improvements to the existing building.

The following bids were received for the subject project:

Fredericks Contractors	\$610,800
MacDougall Pierce Construction	\$832,000
Alderson Commercial Group	\$935,000

Fredericks Contractors was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

The budget for this project was set at \$200,000 last year, which was based on pricing for the office project, marked up for inflation. Last summer staff shared with the Committee a contractor had advised the building addition would likely cost \$300-400,000. Bids were well above that with substantial differences between them. Staff will review pricing and investigate alternatives.

The subject project includes new larger pumps at Lift Station 8 (Ditch Road at Laurelwood), a backup generator, and constructing a new force main north to tie into the new force main manifold near 106th Street and Ditch Road. These improvements will provide buildout wet weather capacity at this lift station by allowing the lift station to send flow directly to the plant. Staff's successful I&I reduction efforts in this basin reduced buildout capacity by nearly 30 percent.

The following bids were received for the subject project:

Brackney, Inc.	\$1,189,500
Lykins Contracting, LLC	\$1,555,790
Ottenweller Contracting, LLC	\$1,826,000

Brackney asked to withdraw their bid due to a substantial mistake of leaving out cost for an electrical subcontractor.

The 2022 Capital Budget included \$1,700,000 overall for this project. Pumps and spare parts, variable frequency drives, emergency generator, automatic transfer switch, and engineering design services already procured amount to \$373,038. Staff estimates \$70,000 for the control panel. Design engineer Commonwealth's estimate for the work was approximately \$1.5 million.

<u>Recommended Action</u>: Award the Lift Station 8 construction contract to Lykins Contracting, LLC for \$1,555,790.

This project includes the extension of the parallel force main along Springmill Road from Jackson's Grant to the new parallel interceptor at 111th Street. This project provides additional capacity for the northeast quarter of our service area including the Springmill Interceptor. The original lift station design included a second larger force main, which is the next step towards buildout capacity of this lift station.

TPI was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

The 2022 Capital Budget included \$1,700,000 overall for this project. Engineering design services are \$68,800.

<u>Recommended Action</u>: Award the Lift Station 26 Parallel Force Main construction contract to TPI Utility Construction, LLC for \$1,431,600.

The 2022 Capital Budget included \$20.5 million in spending from 2022 through 2027. The draft 2023 Capital Budget includes \$22.6 million for that same period. Increased spending is primarily due to increased construction and equipment pricing and added/scheduled plant and collection system equipment replacements. Changes will be discussed at the committee meetings. Staff adjusted ongoing and future projects in the capital budget after bids were received on November 2 for three larger projects (#2202, 2203, and 2207).

The following updates are provided for ongoing capital projects. Please refer to the Capital Project Fact Sheets for background information on individual projects.

• #1902 – TriCo WRRF Expansion

Punch list work continues. Staff continue reviewing change requests and closeout paperwork. Staff anticipates presenting a final change order to the C&C Committee soon.

 #2201 Lift Station 1 (Keystone/99<sup>th</sup> Street) Wet Weather Pump Replacement & Lift Station 2 (106<sup>th</sup>/Spring Mill) Pump #3 Replacement

All equipment has been delivered. Staff installed the new Pump 3 at Lift Station 2. Pump installation at Lift Station 1 includes wet well piping and lining, which will be completed by Pyramid Design and Construction. Work is expected to begin later this year.

• #2202 Lift Station 8 (Laurelwood) Reconstruction

Bids for construction will be presented to the C&C Committee. Construction is anticipated to run through summer of 2023.

• #2207 Lift Station 26 (Jackson's Grant) Parallel Force Main

Bids for construction will be presented to the C&C Committee. Construction is anticipated to run through summer of 2023.

• #2208 Lift Station 16 (Michigan/Sycamore Street) Reconstruction

GRW is finishing final plans. IDEM permits have been received. Staff plans to proceed with public bidding in November or December when The Farm

development project moves forward. Construction is anticipated to run through fall of 2023.

• #2204, 2205 and 2206 Lift Stations 11, 14 and 26 Backup Generators

Delivery of new generators and automatic transfer switches, control panel, and variable frequency drives is now anticipated in spring of 2023. Barth Electric plans to begin construction early spring.

 Lift Stations 18, 20 and 21 Pump Replacements and Lift Station 17 pump impeller upgrades

Equipment has been delivered. Staff will install new pumps at Lift Stations 18 and 20, and new pump impellers at Lift Station 17. Pump installation at Lift Station 21 includes wet well piping and valve replacement, which will be installed with aforementioned work at Lift Station 1 by Pyramid.

Biosolids Building Addition

Bids for construction will be presented to the C&C Committee. Construction is anticipated to run through spring of 2023. The new space includes two bays – one for climate-controlled storage of the vactor truck and the other for a workshop. This project incorporates lighting and HVAC improvements to the existing building.

Staff anticipates proceeding with design of the following projects early next year:

- #2301 Lift Station 10 (Ashbrook) Upgrades
- #2302 Lift Station 23 (126<sup>th</sup> Street/West Clay Elementary) Upgrades
